Problem Statement

Why do we need to put Problem Statement/Task Assigned/Goal/Target/Ambition?

- ▶ Adverse situation brings the best qualities of a person
- ▶ OLA qualities are shown when a man is put into a pressurised situation.

Content of a Story (TAT)

- ▶ Introduction
- ▶ Problem Statement/Task Assigned/Goal/ Achievement
- ▶ Actions

TAT : Introduction

- ▶ Name
- ▶ Age
- ▶ Profession, Education
- ▶ Name of School, University, company name
- ▶ Name of the place

TAT : Problem Statement

- ▶ What led to the situation.
- ▶ You can describe some of your PIQ/SD content in the problem statement
 - ▶ While giving **tuition classes** to your children, you heard . . .
 - ▶ At 7:00 Am when he was on his way to **office**. . .
 - ▶ While he was doing his **NCC duty** in remote area. . .
 - ▶ After winning **Cricket Competition**, on his way to home. . .
 - ▶ After successfully completing the **Cricket Combat League** at the college, while on his way to his friend house. . .
- ▶ Mention Time, Distance and Speed whenever you can. Numbers shows that you are writing a realistic story.

TAT : ACTIONS

- ▶ There must be 6 actions plan written in your story.
- ▶ Thank You, he felt happy and he cleared with flying colors are just a way to loose your one action plan.

Actions : Short Duration Situation

- ▶ This is the best chance to show case your bunch of officer like quality
 - ▶ Planning
 - ▶ Seeking Responsibility
 - ▶ Assigning Task
 - ▶ Coordination
 - ▶ Cooperation
 - ▶ Motivation
 - ▶ Initiative
- ▶ What should be the approach
 - ▶ Take the responsibility/take initiative and take responsibility./take permission
 - ▶ Make plan with Group/Seniors/authority
 - ▶ Discuss the plan and assigned roles & responsibility with the team
 - ▶ Divide your team in small group and make them do work
 - ▶ For every action, you can justify it why you did it.
 - ▶ Encourage them, keep track
 - ▶ Combine the result of team
 - ▶ Completed the task

Recommended Candidate Story : Structure

- ▶ Introduction (Include 5 Points)
- ▶ Accurate Problem mentioned in confined words
- ▶ 6 Actions
- ▶ Clear in planning
- ▶ Groupism is shown (So there must be teams working together)
- ▶ Multiple resources are being used
- ▶ Actions are Crystal clear, accurate step by step
- ▶ Numbers are mentioned (Speed, Distance, Time, No of People)
- ▶ There should be a significant purpose of task you doing.
